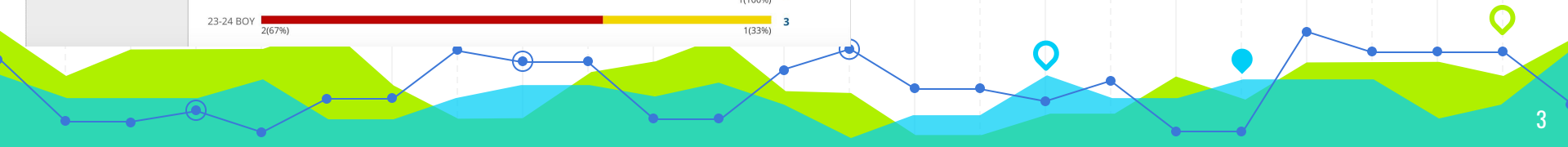

Students with IEP at Campo Elementary

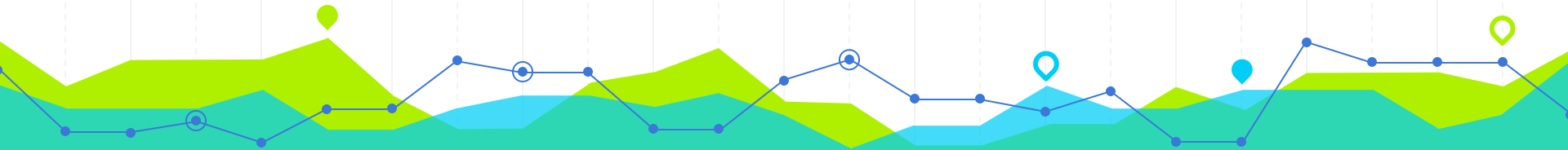


AI Students with IEP at Campo

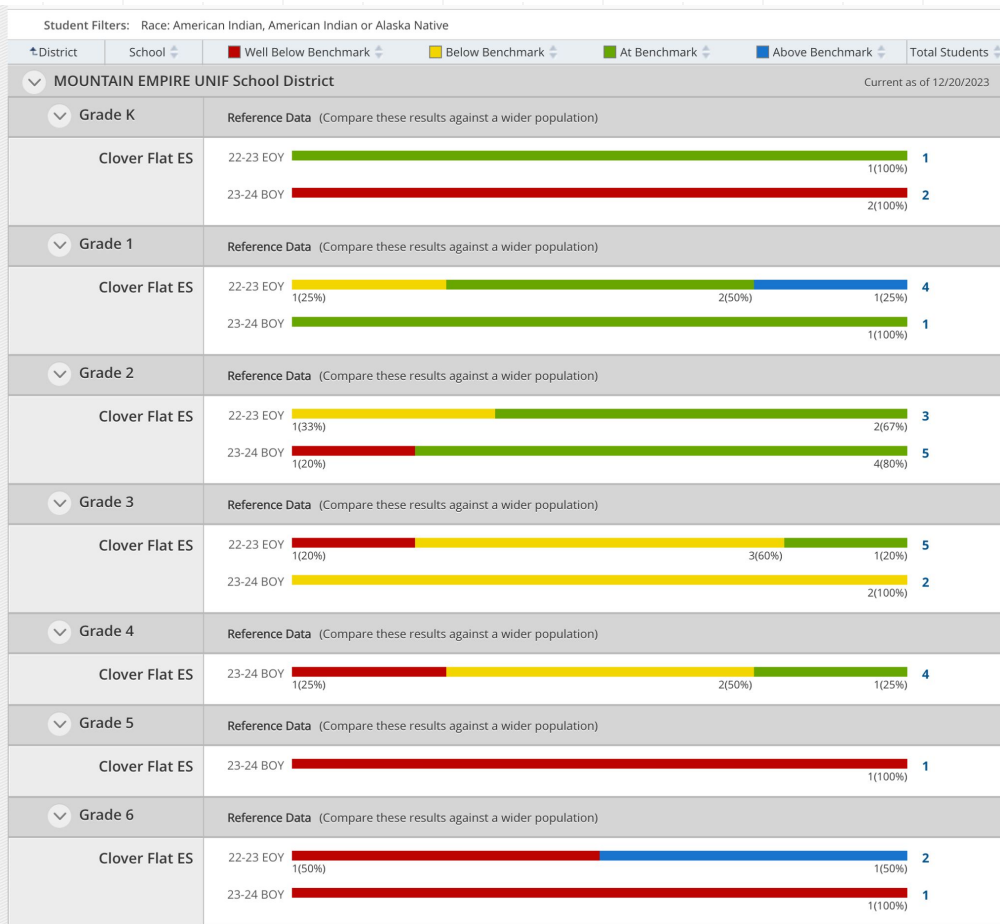

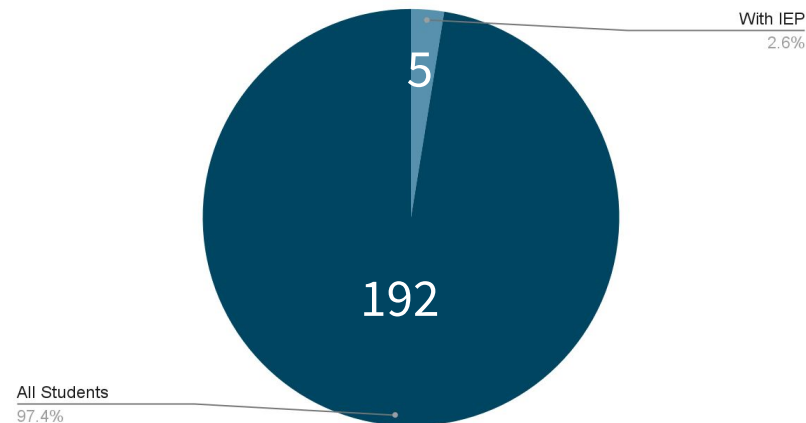

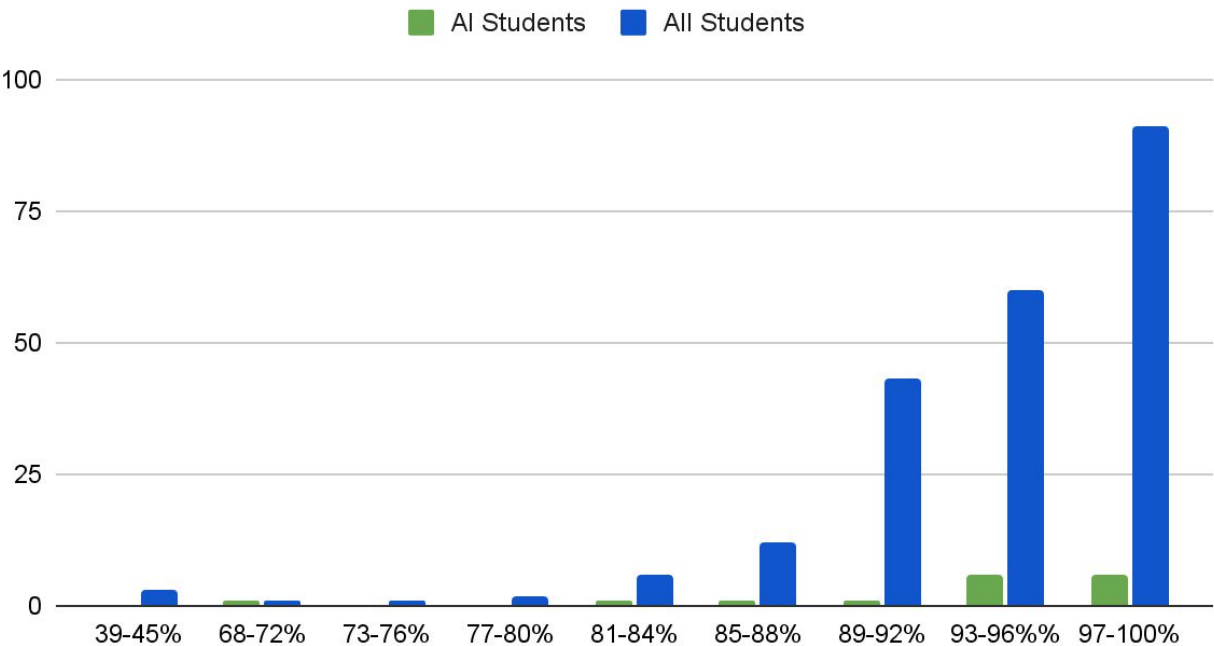

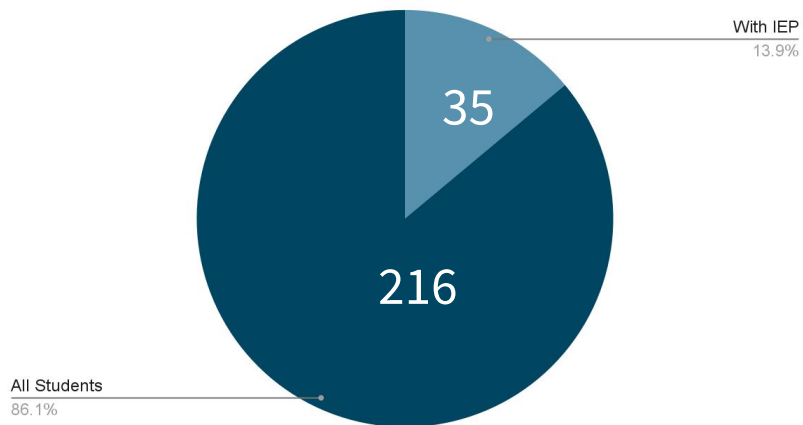

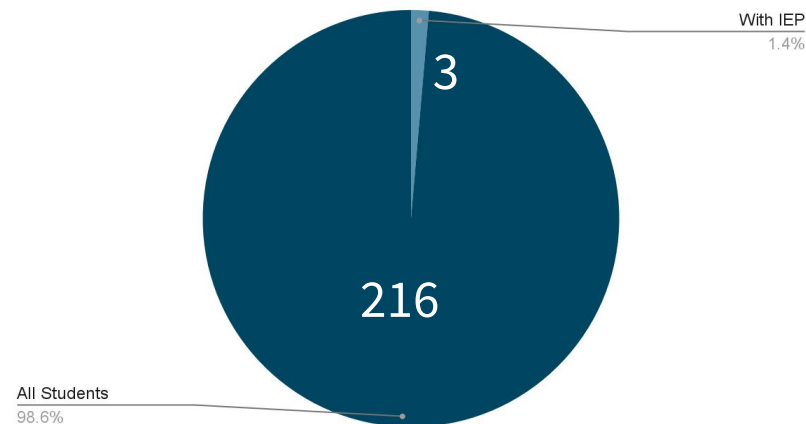

Students with IEP at Descanso

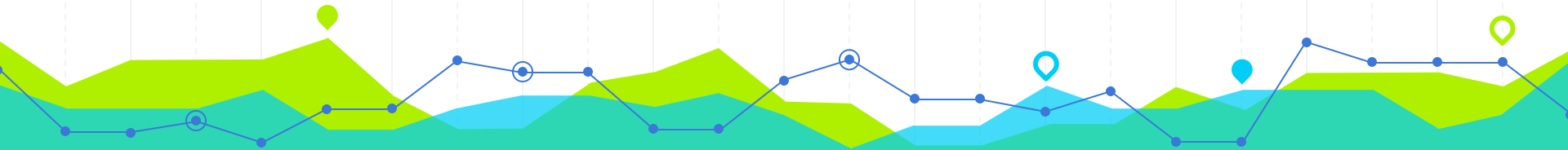


AI Students with IEP at Descanso

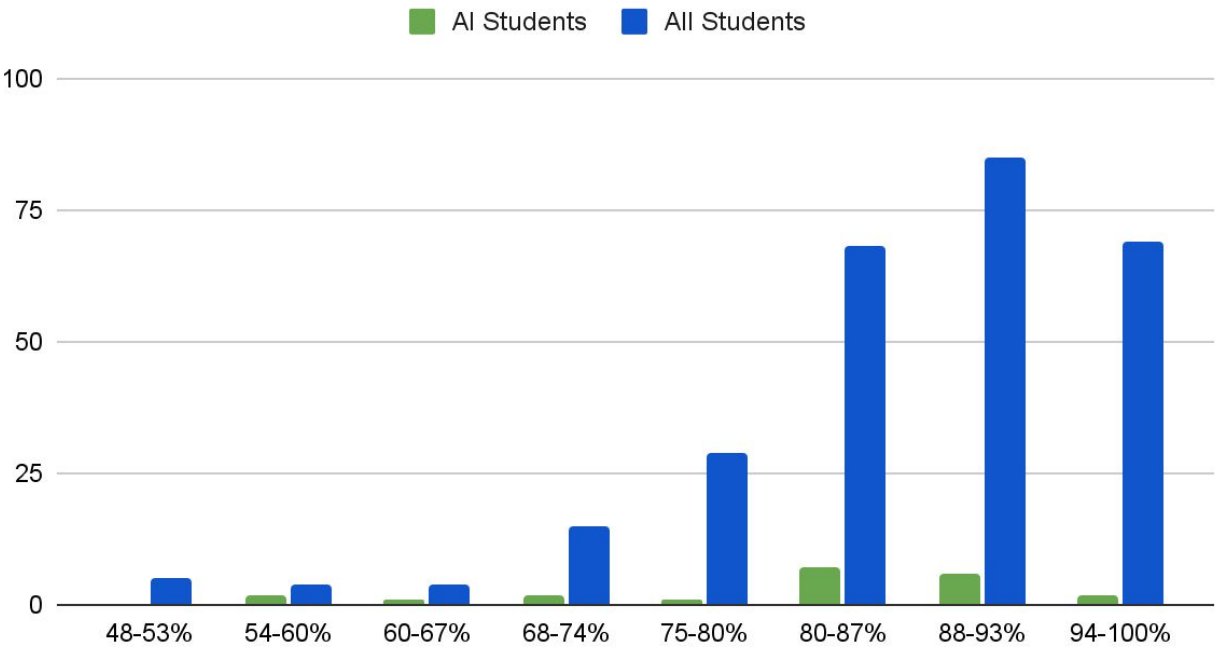

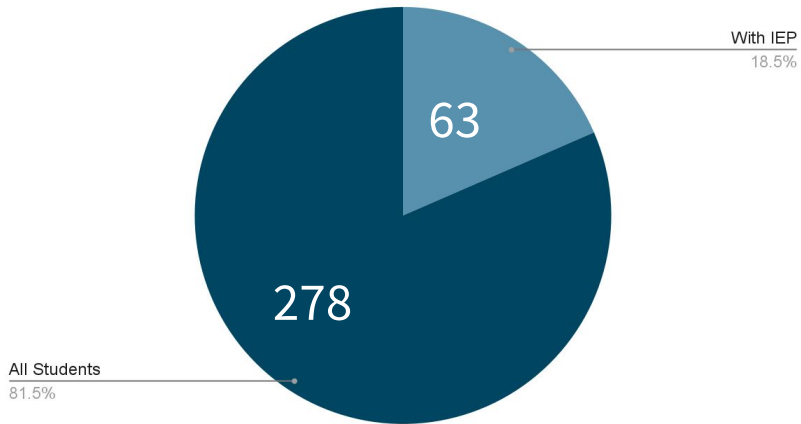

MEJH Attendance Rates - AI Students

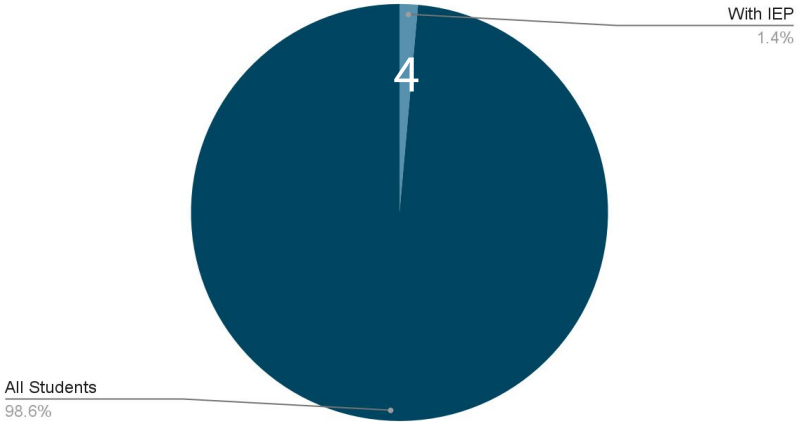

AI Data for 2023-24



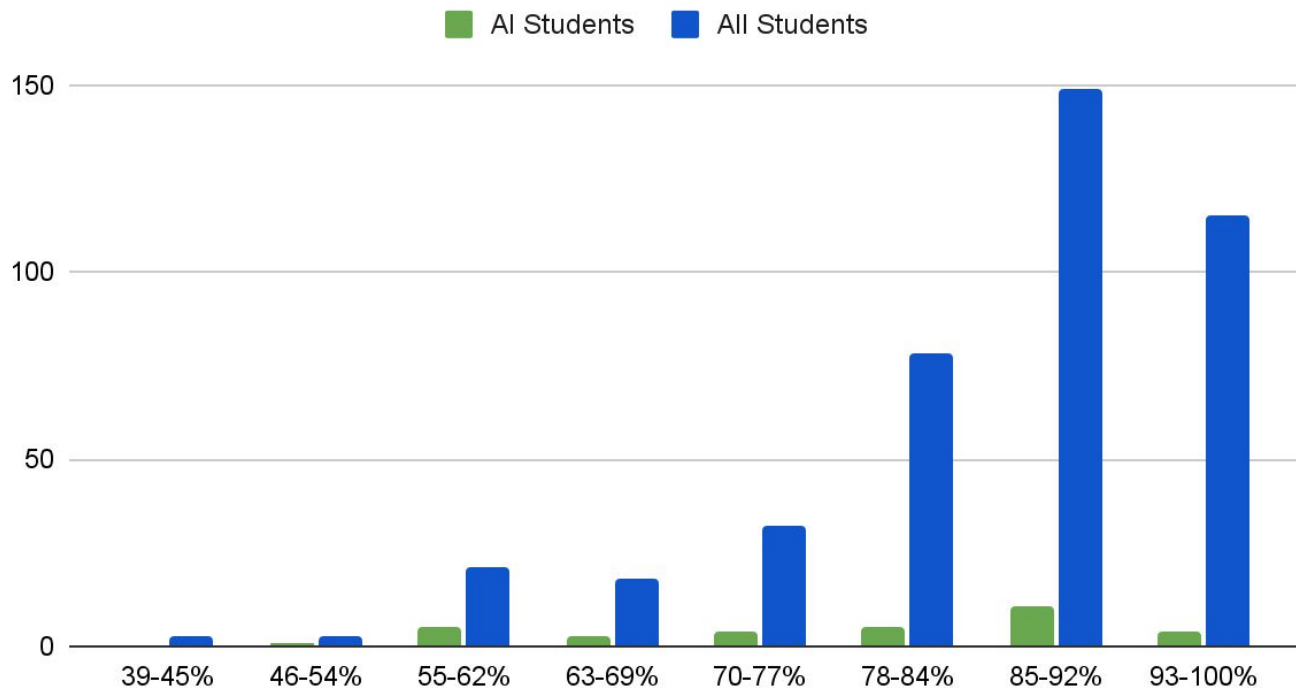
- **46% of AI students have failed 2 or more core classes. (They can all still easily graduate in 4 years due to block sched)**
- **Overall AI Attendance Rate = 83%**
- **13% of AI students have an IEP. (5 of 39)**

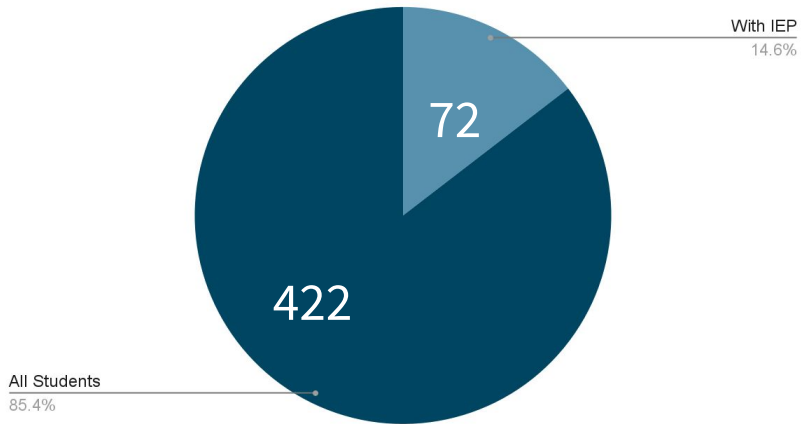
MEHS Attendance Rates - AI Students



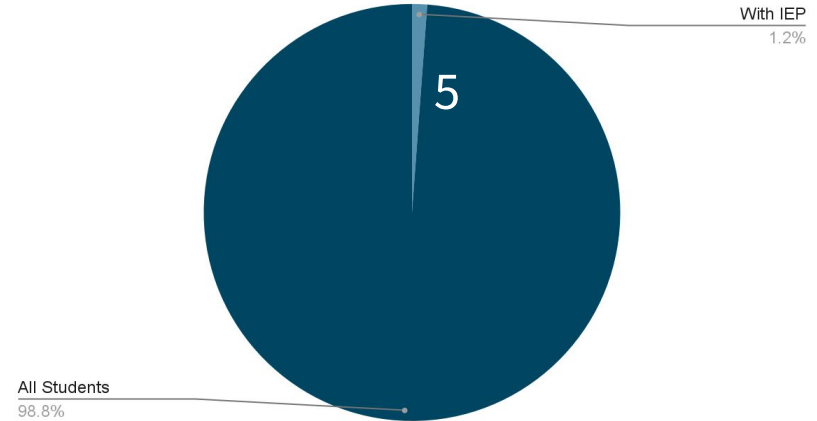

## One on One Advising

EAOP students receive mentorship from a current UC San Diego or Community College student.

# SUMMER RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

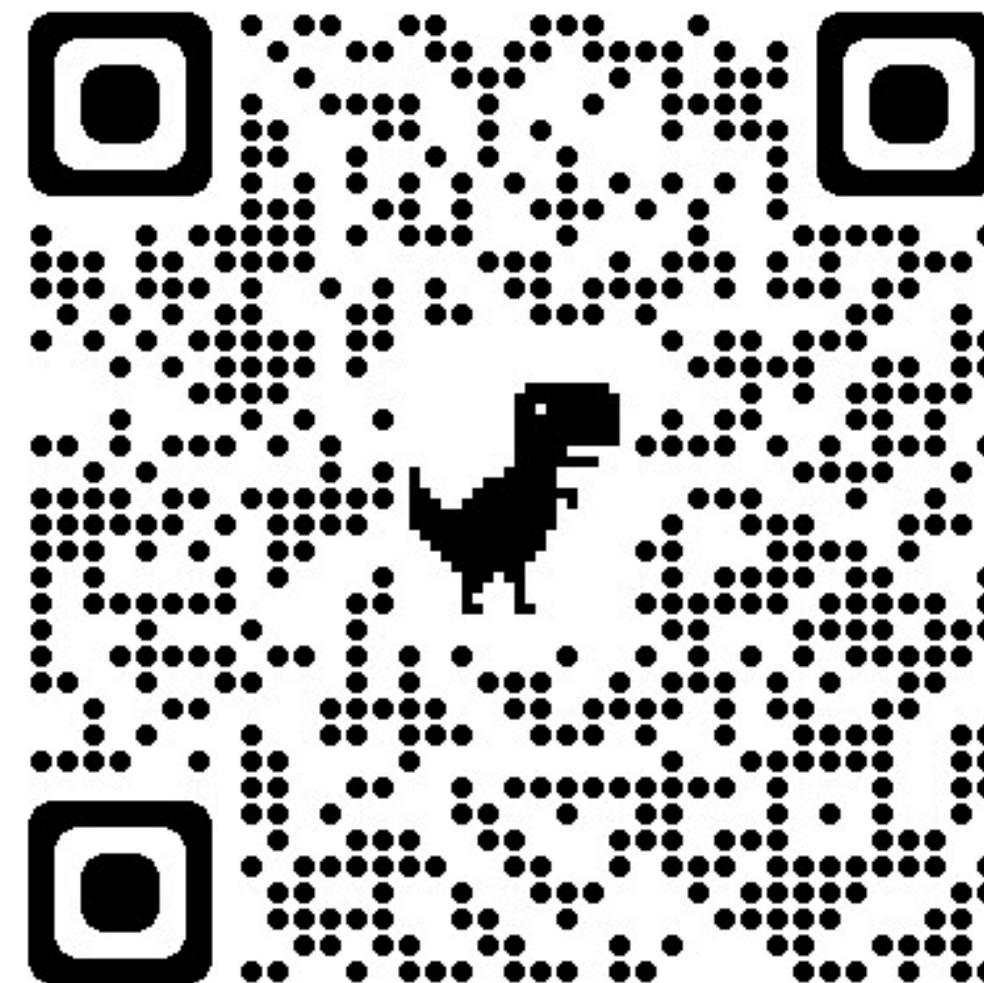

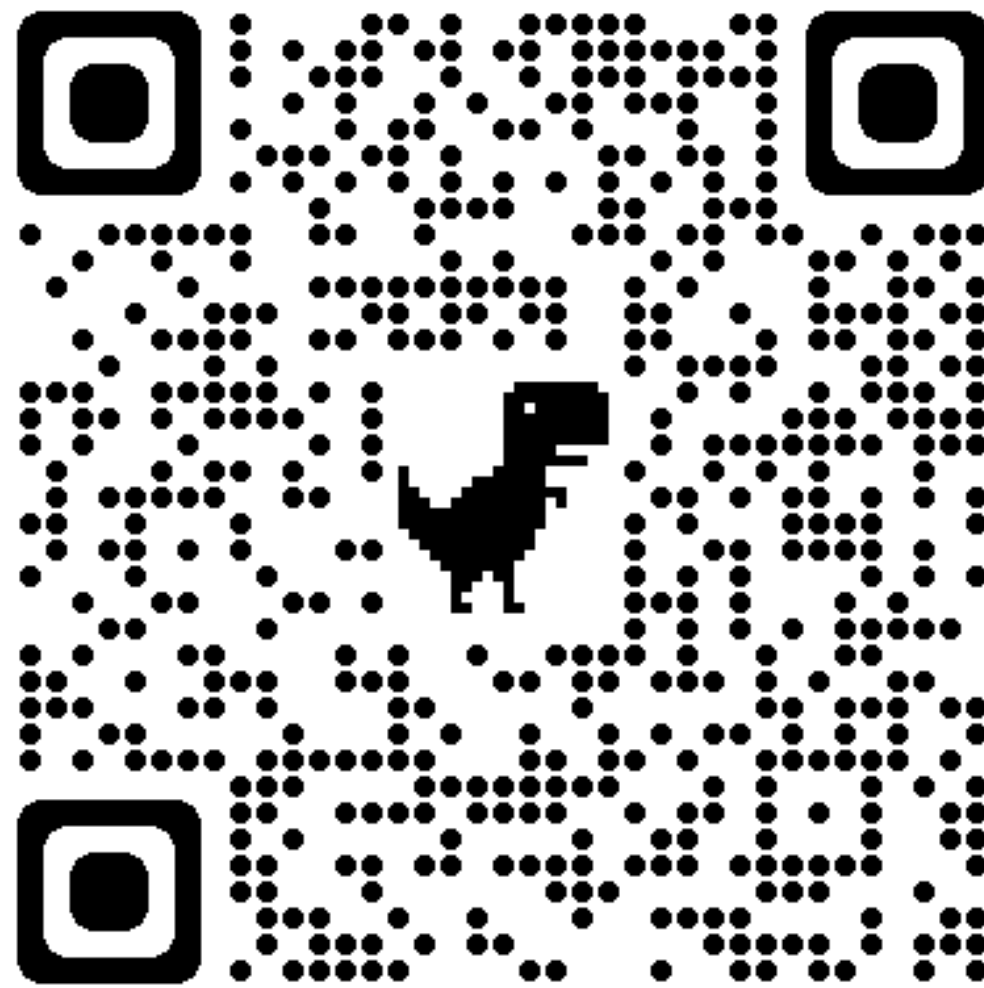
